He reported that the tourism industry generates substantial income for the county.

He highlighted NKDC workshop initiate including new units at the old refuse collection depot at Metheringham. He recommended Whisby Nature Reserve, IBCC, Mrs Smith's Cottage (currently being reroofed) and adjacent visitors centre, He would send his full report to the clerk for circulation.
